The Venue

Bundanon is an art museum embedded in the landscape and a wildlife sanctuary set on 1000 hectares. Located twenty minutes from Nowra, on the Shoalhaven River and offering a range of activities to encourage exploration, consideration and development of art. Transport will be via coach, departing (and returning) Albury, with pick up/drop off points at Holbrook and Gundagai. This is a residential camp, with students staying on the Bundanon site.
