

# Nepean Festival of Arts & Design

## Terms and conditions of entry



- Submission Eligibility** - All submissions must be original artworks and should not have been exhibited in the Nepean Festival of Arts and Design of the previous year (2023).
- Submission Limits** - Each artist may submit one artwork. The Committee reserves the right to invite additional submissions (up to 3 per artist); Artists may also request to submit additional pieces, subject to approval.
- Submissions Deadline** - No new entries or amendments to existing entries will be accepted after the exhibition catalogue has been compiled.
- Entry Form** - All submissions must include a completed entry form and a sample work. The information provided in the entry form will be used for correspondence, including notification of winners.
- Sample Artworks** - Artists must submit one of the following with their entry form:
  - A high-quality sample/photograph of the artwork intended to be exhibited.
  - A high-quality sample/photograph that demonstrates the Artist's practice and works. *Please note that the sample does not have to be the final submission for exhibition.*
- Exhibition Selection** - A total of 100 artists' works will be selected for the final exhibition. All decisions made by the Committee regarding the selection and display of artworks are final.
- Exhibition Rights** - The Committee reserve the right to display, hang, or showcase the submitted artwork as deemed appropriate. The Committee retain the right to reject any artwork that is deemed inappropriate or offensive.
- Website Rights** - Nepean CAPA High School reserves the right to display images of the festival and submitted artworks on the school's website for promotional and archival purposes.
- Size Limitations** - All artworks, whether framed or unframed, must not exceed 2 meters on the longest side.
- Sale of Artworks** - All artworks must be clearly labeled with the following details: title, artist's name, contact information, and sale price (if applicable). Artworks offered for sale will be subject to a 30% commission on the sale price.
- Pricing of Artworks** - The sale price for individual artworks must not exceed AUD \$5000.00
- Payment Information for Sales** - For artworks offered for sale, Artists must provide bank details (BSB and account number) to facilitate payment by bank transfer should their work be sold.
- Artworks Not for Sale (NFS)** - Artists may choose to submit their artwork as "Not for Sale", but must still assign the work a monetary value that does not exceed the stated limit.
- Judging Decisions** - All decisions made by the judging panel are final and cannot be appealed.
- Liability & Insurance** - Organisers will take reasonable care in handling the artworks, but will not be held liable for any loss or damage to the artwork in exhibition or transit. Artists are responsible for arranging their own insurance if needed.
- GST & Tax** - It is the responsibility of each artist to determine their GST/tax status (whether as a hobbyist or professional artist) and to make the appropriate contributions to the Australian Taxation Office (ATO) in the event of a sale.
- Copyright & Indemnity** - By signing the entry form, the artist confirms that they own the copyright to the submitted work and agrees to indemnify Nepean CAPA High School staff against any claims of copyright infringement.
- Acceptance of Terms** - Submission of the entry form constitutes the artist's acceptance of these terms and conditions.
